PURPOSE



The Graduate Student Research Poster Contest recognizes excellence in research in various minerals-related fields by SME. The contest provides an opportunity for the graduate students to showcase their work in a visible setting and to compete for cash prizes based on the quality of their posters as determined by a team of judges. Graduate student education contributes to research in mining and mineral studies.

The Graduate Student Research Poster Contest is open to any SME student member currently enrolled in a minerals-related graduate program. Accepted posters will be on display throughout the 2019 SME Annual Conference. The contestants must be present at a predetermined time to discuss their research with interested attendees and to answer questions posed by the judges. The judging team will consist of five members from academia, industry and government. A rubric for judging the posters will be prepared in advance of the contest and made available to the contestants.

TOPIC: Open topic reflecting the graduate's thesis.

ABSTRACT: The abstract is limited to 200 words and is due by December 30, 2018.

It should describe what the graduate student intends to display on the

poster and a brief description of the research.

CRITERION: The entries will be judged on:

1. Technical competence

2. Thoroughness of approach

3. Quality of the delivery and oral presentation

PRIZES: 1st Place - \$1200 plus a dinner ticket 2nd Place - \$1000 plus a dinner ticket

3rd Place - \$800 plus a dinner ticket
